

Information needed for Marriage License

Effective July 1, 2021-Application fee is \$57.00

If Premarital Education is completed the application fee is \$37.00

WE ONLY ACCEPT CASH OR CREDIT CARD FOR MARRIAGE APPLICATIONS-NO CHECKS

A Certificate of Premarital Education must be presented at the time of application to receive the discounted fee

A Marriage License expires 60 days from the date it is issued

Each applicant will need to provide the following information to complete the application process:

- Proof of age: Certified copy of a birth certificate, or driver's license are most common
- Full legal name
- Maiden name if different from current legal name
- Current address
- Date of birth
- Race
- Number of previous marriages
- How did last marriage end/date of divorce, death, or annulment
- Social Security number
- Name of parents (mother's maiden name)
- Parent's place of birth (city and state)
- Highest grade completed in school and number of years of college if any

The age of consent for marriage for both parties is 18 years of age, there is not waiting period if applicants are of legal age. If the applicant is 16 or 17 years of age, written, notarized consent from the applicant's parents or legal guardian is required. If an applicant is under the age of 16, a marriage license can only be issued by an order from a circuit judge. If either applicant is under the age of 18, the license may not be issued until two full days elapse after the day the application is filed.
